**LENTEN REGULATIONS :**

**FASTING:** All the faithful between the ages 18 and 59 are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting means limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Two very light meals are permitted.

**ABSTINENCE:** All the faithful who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> year are bound to Abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

**EASTER DUTY:** After a person has received First Communion, a person must receive Communion at least once a year, during the Easter Season.

The Easter Season begins with the First Sunday of Lent (Feb. 18<sup>th</sup>) and continues until Pentecost (May 19<sup>th</sup>). Reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) is encouraged during Lent, especially if a person has been away from Sunday Mass.
