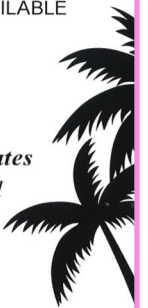

LENTEN REGULATIONS :

FASTING: All the faithful between the ages 18 and 59 are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting means limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Two very light meals are permitted.

ABSTINENCE: All the faithful who have reached their 14th year are bound to Abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

EASTER DUTY: After a person has received First Communion, a person must receive Communion at least once a year, during the Easter Season.


The Easter Season begins with the First Sunday of Lent (Feb. 18th) and continues until Pentecost (May 19th). Reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) is encouraged during Lent, especially if a person has been away from Sunday Mass.
