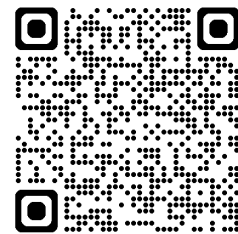

In the church this weekend, there are copies of a marvelous letter from our seminarian, Robert! His Letter of THANKS is filled with love and encouragement for our community as we continue to pray for and foster vocations to give Glory to God!

Father Carlos R. Quijano SJ was born in San Salvador, El Salvador. Thanks to his education with the Jesuits, from a very young age he participated together with his two brothers in the Christian social movement that would lead the popular revolt of the 70s and 80s in El Salvador. Three of his Jesuit teachers, who had inspired his vocational discernment, would end up martyred in November 1989, when the army of that country executed the Jesuit Community of the Central American University (UCA). Forced to go into exile in the early 80s with his family in Canada: where he would learn not only French but also to appreciate the rigors of polar winter; he would complete his studies in Secondary Education and school psychology, before entering the Jesuit Novitiate in Montreal in 1986. The long human and spiritual formation typical of the Society of Jesus would lead him to study and work in the Dominican Republic where he would do his teaching -or Regency- in France, Kenya and California. Immediately after his Ordination to the priesthood in Montreal in 1998, he was sent to Miami to work teaching French and Spanish at the Belén Jesuit Preparatory School and after a year he would go to Boston MA, where he would complete his theological training at the Weston Jesuit School of Theology, now part of Boston College. There he would meet a classmate, a Jesuit from the province of NY Fr Rocco Danzi SJ who would invite him to work on the parish team at St. Ignatius of Loyola Church, Crown Heights, Brooklyn —where he worked from the summer of 2001 until 2011 when the Jesuit order withdrew from that parish. Since then and with the permission of his Provincial, he has been collaborating in different parishes of the diocese: Saint Brigid in Bushwick, Blessed Sacrament in Jackson Heights, and until June 30 in Saint Paul in Corona... and **now at St. Athanasius/St. Dominic** back in Brooklyn! Father Quijano SJ has, among other devotions, the close and very important presence in his spiritual journey of Saint Óscar Arnulfo Romero - the martyred bishop who was canonized in October 2018 in Rome (a devotion shared by his mother + Mrs. Marta Quijano Durán.) May Saint Ignatius of Loyola, whose feast day we are about to celebrate on July 31, always help us to be a leaven of change to announce without hesitation the Kingdom of God — a kingdom of Justice and Peace— and help us fight against temptations and injustices in this world!

Padre Carlos R. Quijano SJ nació en San Salvador, El Salvador. Gracias a su educación con los Jesuitas, desde muy joven participó junto con sus dos hermanos en el movimiento social cristiano que protagonizaría la revuelta popular de los años 70s y 80s en El Salvador. Tres de sus maestros jesuitas, que habían inspirado su discernimiento vocacional terminarían martirizados en Noviembre de 1989, cuando el ejército de ese país ejecutaron a la Comunidad Jesuita de la Universidad Centroamericana (UCA). Obligado a exiliarse a principios de los 80s junto a su familia en Canadá: donde aprendería no solamente Francés sino también a apreciar los rigores del invierno polar canadiense, completaría sus estudios en Educación secundaria y psicología escolar, antes de ingresar al Noviciado Jesuita en Montreal en 1986. La larga formación humana y espiritual típica de la Compañía de Jesús lo llevaría a estudiar y trabajar en República Dominicana donde haría su magisterio o Regency-, Francia, Kenia y California. Inmediatamente después de su Ordination sacerdotal en Montreal en 1998, fue enviado a Miami a trabajar enseñando Francés y Español en el Belén Jesuit Preparatory School y después de un año iría a Boston MA, donde completaría su formación teológica en el Weston Jesuit School of Theology ahora parte de Boston College. Ahí conocería a un compañero de clase a un jesuita de la provincia de NY: p. Rocco Danzi SJ quien lo invitaría a y trabajar en el equipo parroquial en la Iglesia de San Ignacio de Loyola, Crown Heights, Brooklyn y donde trabajó desde el verano del 2001 hasta 2011 cuando la orden Jesuita se retiró de esa parroquia. Desde entonces y con el permiso de su Provincial ha estado colaborando en diferentes parroquias de la diócesis: Santa Brígida en Bushwick, Santísimo Sacramento en Jackson Heights y hasta el 30 de Junio en San Pablo en Corona. Y ahora en **St. Atanasio/St. Domingo** de regreso en Brooklyn! Padre Quijano SJ tiene entre otras devociones la presencia cercana y muy importante en su itinerario espiritual de San Óscar Arnulfo Romero- el obispo mártir quien fuera canonizado en octubre de 2018 en Roma. Devoción compartida por su madre +doña Marta Quijano Durán. Que San Ignacio de Loyola cuya festividad estamos próximos a celebrar el 31 de Julio nos ayude siempre a ser fermento de cambio para anunciar sin vacilaciones el Reino de Dios que es un reino de Justicia y de Paz y nos ayude a luchar contra las tentaciones e injusticias de este mundo!




