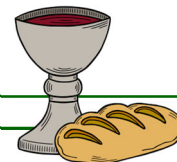

On January 10th, 2026, Pope Leo XIV proclaimed the special Jubilee Year of Saint Francis. This was proclaimed in commemoration with the 800th years since Saint Francis death.

This Franciscan Jubilee Year, considered a gift for the entire Church and an occasion for authentic spiritual renewal with a decree issued by the Apostolic Penitentiary of the Holy See. Until Jan. 10 of next year, the faithful can obtain this grace under the usual conditions — sacramental confession, Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the pope — by making a pilgrimage to any Franciscan conventual church or place of worship dedicated to St. Francis anywhere in the world.

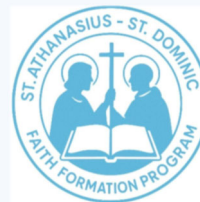

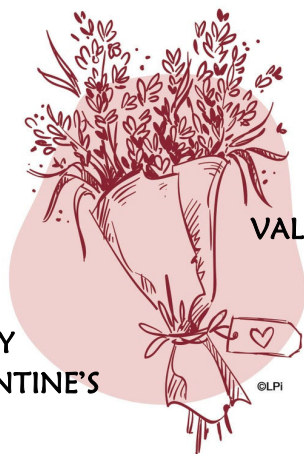
