LENTEN REGULATIONS :

FASTING: All the faithful between the ages 18 and 59 are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting means limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Two very light meals are permitted.

ABSTINENCE: All the faithful who have reached their 14th year are bound to Abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

EASTER DUTY: After a person has received First Communion, a person must receive Communion at least once a year, during the Easter Season.

The Easter Season begins with the First Sunday of Lent (Feb 21st) and continues until Pentecost (May 24th). Reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) is encouraged during Lent, especially if a person has been away from Sunday Mass.

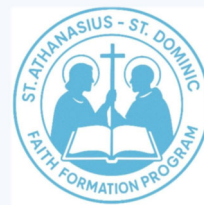

The **Season of Lent** calls us to these three points of focus in this 40 day period:

~ **Prayer/Oration:** “Talking to God” is always a good thing to do – especially in this season of hope and promise. Making time every morning or evening, simply to thank God for the blessings you have/ experience in your daily life is a way to make your Lent shine!

~ **Fasting/Ayuno:** Staying away from favorite foods is one way to extend the idea of fasting beyond Fridays in Lent. “Giving up” can also be a gift of time. You can take on an extra chore to assist a neighbor or family member in these season-changing days.

~ **Almsgiving/Limosna:** Caring for the poor is a particular charism in this time of year. Perhaps you can put aside some extra change or a dedicated amount (the cost of a latte) and accumulate a total sum that can then be given to a charity of your choice to express your own concern for those in need.
