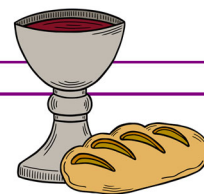

Thank you for your continued support of our parish. Some years ago, we embarked on Generations of Faith. It appears that there is a surplus in the account for us to be able to draw-down, if/ when we can amend the original case statement (convent basement renovations, HVAC) for current need.

You know we are in debt to the Diocese for the renovations to St Dominic Church done some time ago; an amended case statement to take into account the cost of that work will allow us to reduce the debt substantially.

To that end, in collaboration with the Pastoral Council and the Finance Council, I will amend said case statement to reflect our current need for reducing this debt, while also continuing to focus on the necessary improvements that warranted our recent \$450,000 loan debt for repairs.

I am grateful for all of your support to the parish. I thank you for your understanding of this change as I —with you — endeavor to be good stewards of our resources.

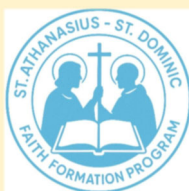
