Periodically you will see news and notes in this space reflecting information on parish finances.

Our REGULAR (i.e. SUNDAY) monthly income **DOES NOT** keep pace with REGULAR parish expenses; we are drawing on savings to pay our ordinary monthly bills.

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Our Average **weekly income** : **\$19,475.96** (Sunday collection, special collections/Masses. SACA rent, etc)

Our Average **weekly expenses**: **\$20,941.51** (utilities, salaries/benefits, insurance, office/ household, etc.)

Our Average **weekly shortfall**: **-\$1,465.55**

Cumulative shortfall for the year (x52 weeks) = -\$76, 208.60

Our projected deficit ~\$232,000

In Addition we have facilitated a LOAN from the Diocese (\$450,000) for the Tower/ Boiler repairs.

It is a 'line-of-credit' for 24 months with a following 5-year / 5.5% interest payback ~ **We have begun to pay interest on the principal** (Remember we are also paying-down the balance on the loan for the interior of St Dominic, currently ~\$75K)

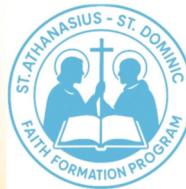
