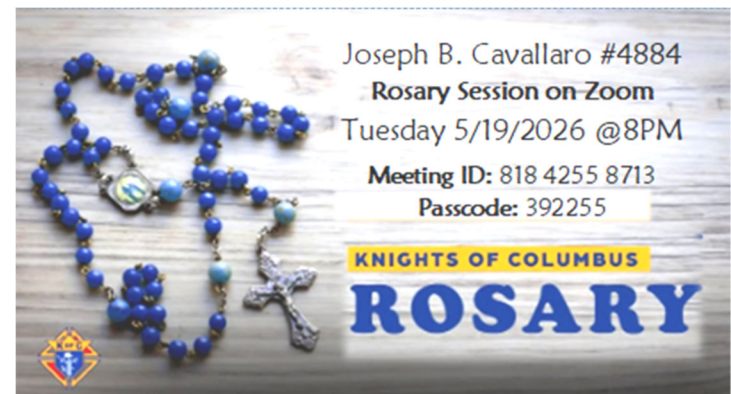

The registration fee is **\$120 per student**. For all children over the age of 6 who have not yet been baptized, they are required to study for one year in order to be baptized.

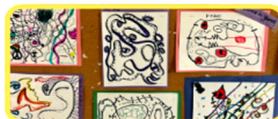

~ Our Parish **FISCAL YEAR** spans SEPTEMBER 1st thru AUGUST 31st.
MAY brings us to our 3rd Quarter (Mar-Apr-May).

This is the time of year when our **Parish Finance Council**, along with our accountant, will begin deliberations and consider cost assumptions for the coming Fiscal Year ~ 2026-2027.

As you are already aware, our parish is operating in a **deficit**.

We have successfully cut expenses by \$700,000; we still have “belt-tightening” to do!

There are a few things we are asking you all to consider:

~ Our **ENVELOPES** cost nearly \$7,500 per year (mailing, printing, processing). If you would consider migrating to our ON-LINE giving, we would begin to reduce costs. You would still have access to giving records and tax letters for your year-end calculations. GiveCentral.org/STA

~ Our **weekly income** for Sundays does **NOT** meet our **weekly expenses**.
