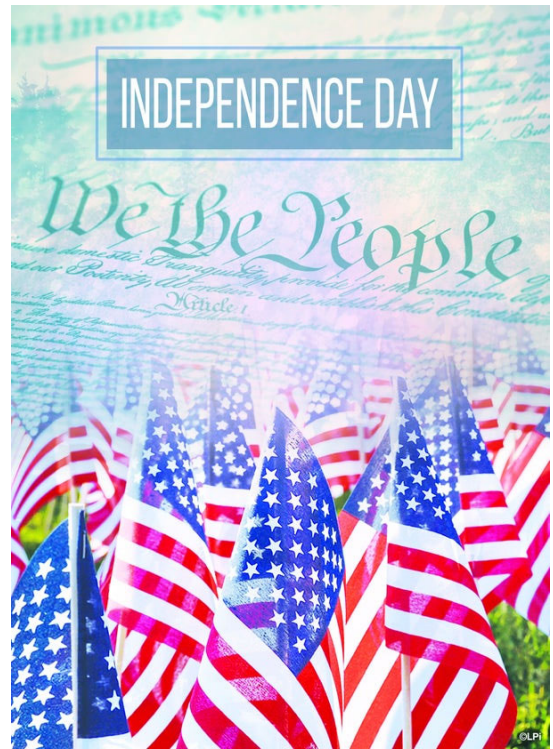

Our registrations for the new course **2026-2027** will begin on **June 2nd**. This is for all children ages 6 & up.

The registration fee is **\$130 per student**. For all children over the age of 6 who have not yet been baptized, they are required to study for one year in order to be baptized.
